



Trees of the Burial Ground

There are 8 species of trees and 2 shrubs located in the Burial Ground area at the University of Richmond. A total of 37 individuals were surveyed. In addition to location and species, many other attributes were collected such as estimated age, height, diameter and condition. This information will be included in an ongoing effort to complete a campus wide tree inventory which was started in 2012.

Map Notes: The estimated age for the oldest trees are also labeled. For example, the lighter orange circle with the label of 210 yrs indicates where the oldest tree, a 210 year old white oak, is located.
